The Organikins as part of the Organic ScoreCard[©] (OSC) is a tool that can help us to identify our life strategy very accurately.

The word Organikin derives from 'next of kin' — in other words your closest family. (Next of kin — those persons who are most closely related to a given person.)

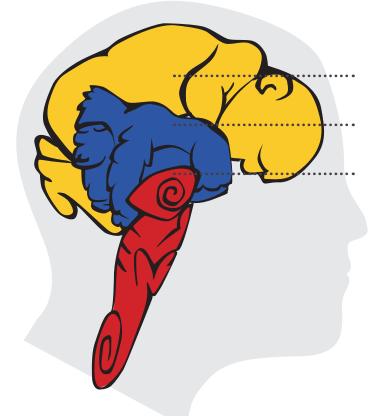

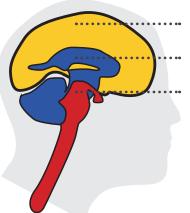

Always willing to be there for others, no matter who they are. Enormous trust in

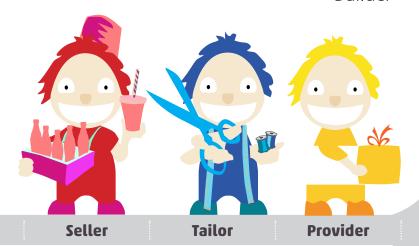

Elders have a natural delegation power everyone does what they need to do but within a larger context of doing things together.

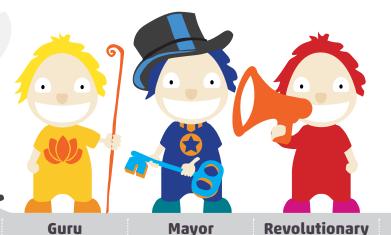
They can and want to work without someone watching over their shoulder.

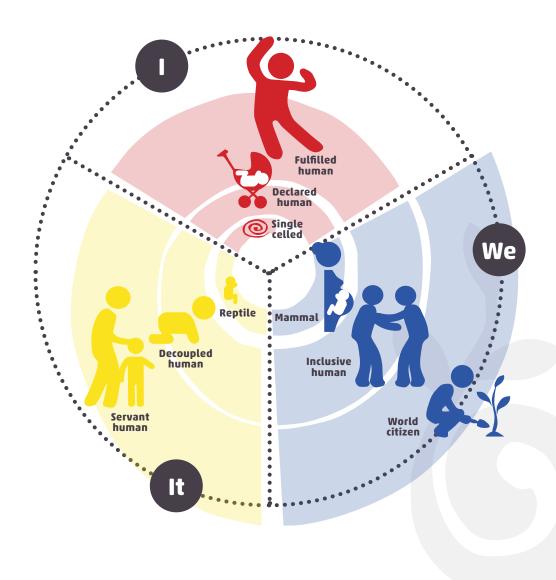

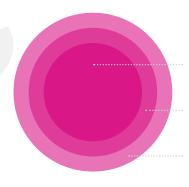
